


Como, the town of Alessandro Volta

PORTA TORRE IN PIAZZA VITTORIA

• It's a place where we can see the remains of a wall of the middle age around the city

TORRE DI SAN VITALE

It's another tower of the wall around the city of the middle age.
Its base is pentagonal and has openings on the vertical sides.





BASILICA DI SAN FEDELE

• It's a cathedral (basilica in Italian) in Roman and Baroque style.

• It's the Palazzo Giovio, from the surname of a Como family, in the Medaglie d'Oro 1 square.
